



Announcement of Ramkhamhaeng University
Subject The Policy of Non-Acceptance of Gifts and Rewards
for the Performance of Duties (No Gift Policy)
Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

Ramkhamhaeng University recognizes the importance of preventing corruption and building a culture of integrity within the organization. This aligns with the Cabinet resolution on December 8, 2020, which approved the National Reform Plan for the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (revised edition). Specifically, Reform Activity 4 aims to develop the Thai civil service into a transparent and benefit-free system. Goal 1.1 requires all government agencies to declare themselves as entities where every official does not accept gifts or rewards of any kind from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

As the top executive of Ramkhamhaeng University, I hereby declare the intention that Ramkhamhaeng University is an agency where all executives and government officials do not accept gifts or rewards of any kind from performing their duties (No Gift Policy), both before and after the performance of such duties, which could lead to corruption and misconduct. We shall work together to create a culture of integrity and good values in performing duties with virtue, transparency, and fairness. This shall be practiced as an organizational culture of integrity. We will not engage in any act that creates a conflict of interest between personal and public benefit, and will not accept property or any other benefits that can be calculated in monetary value from anyone, except for property or benefits received in accordance with laws, rules, or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of the law. Exceptions also include property or benefits received on a moral basis according to the criteria and amounts set by the NACC Commission. Furthermore, we will conduct ourselves according to the ethical standards for government officials to ensure compliance with the corporate governance policy, adhering to the principles of good governance to strengthen an organizational culture of ethics and transparency.
